### WALK IN INTERVIEW

Walk in interview for appointing TWO Guest Faculties to teach B. Sc. (Hons.) and M. Sc. (Hons.) classes under CBCS during the Even Semesters of the academic year 2019-2020 (January-May, 2020), will be held on Friday, 20.02.2020 at 11.30 AM in the Office of the Chairperson, Department of Microbiology, Panjab University, Chandigarh (as per the following tentative teaching schedule):

All the applicants are advised to bring their original certificates and other relevant documents for verification along with the duly filled form giving the details at the time of interview. The application form for the post of Assistant Professor is available at website (<https://jobs.puchd.ac.in/forms.php> pages 1 to 9) and the same is to be submitted in the office of the Department of Microbiology, Panjab University, Chandigarh by 10.00 am on the date of the interview.

The above assignment will be on lecture basis with a token honorarium of Rs.1000/- per lecture with an upper limit of Rs.25000/- per month. The candidate shall have to give an undertaking that he/she will not draw any fellowship/stipend or any financial assistance from any agency till they are teaching in the Department of Microbiology, Panjab University, Chandigarh as a Guest Faculty. The candidates who are already availing JRF scholarships in the University are not entitled for the honorarium but they will be issued experience certificate for the Guest Faculty.

#### Essential Qualification:

- i) Master's degree in Microbiology with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university. A relaxation of 5% shall be provided for the candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe/Differently-abled/Other Backward Classes (OBC)(Non-creamy Layer)/ Ph.D. Degree holders, who have obtained their Master's Degree prior to 19 September, 1991.

- ii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET or who are or have been awarded a Ph. D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission. Provided further, candidates registered for the Ph.D. programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions : a) Ph.D. degree of the candidate awarded in regular mode only; b) Evaluation of the Ph.D. thesis by at least two external examiners; c) An open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate had been conducted; d) Candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work out of which at least one must be in a refereed journal; e) Candidate has made at least two presentations in conference/seminars, based on his/her Ph. D work. (a) to (e) as above are to be certified by the Registrar/ Dean (Academic Affairs).

Desirable qualification:

Ph.D in Microbiology or allied fields.
